


## To gain access to your course material on the ATT VLE:



- Click the category and then the course that you would like to enrol on. You will now be asked to enter an enrolment key into the box – it is case sensitive (ignore any PayPal requests).

**NOTE: Your college lecturer/instructor will supply you with this key.**

Enrolment key:
